Pasco County Human Services provides case management to citizens across Pasco County. We utilize a holistic approach where we work with the citizen to create a plan and work together toward the goal of self-sufficiency.

What we help with:

- May assist with applications for Medicaid, Medicare, or Food Stamps.
- Connect our most vulnerable citizens to resources in the community they may not know are available to them.
- Connect to local support groups for different needs, such as grief counseling, substance abuse, caregiver support, and mental health.
- Support through job seeking, resume building, and creating a budget.
- Collaborate with providers for subsidized childcare.
- Collaborate with providers for GED programs, college, or vocational programs.
- Support with basic needs such as food pantries, clothing, and toiletry resources.
- Solve transportation needs to medical and non-medical appointments through bus passes, med-cabs and connecting to GoPasco Paratransit.
- Connect citizens to a local legal aid provider.

 - If referring a citizen, confirm that they know they are being referred and are interested in case management.

We do not, currently, provide direct rental assistance, or direct services to assist the homeless. We will however be able to enroll a citizen into our case management program to work with them to find other resources.
