The Pasco Sheriff's Office Victim Advocates are a specialized civilian unit whose focus is to ensure that the rights of victims are honored. They receive special training in all aspects of victimization, with a victim centered approach. They also provide information and support throughout the entire investigative and criminal justice process. Victim Advocates continually assess the needs of victims and provide support from the onset of victimization, sometimes from crime scene to courtroom and beyond. They maintain a current listing of community resources to include referrals for counseling, legal aid, emergency food and shelter, safe housing and support groups.
